

Fishing in Lake Revsund

Revsundssjön lake is the place where memories are created and simmer. A first-time stop at the lake often becomes a recurring tradition for those wanting to explore it in full. The lake is dotted with islets, rocky outcrops, sandy beaches and cliffs. It's also a neverending source of good and completely true fishing stories.

In winter you can go ice-fishing on Revsundssjön lake, and in summer you can either fish from the shore or rent a boat. Aside from Revsundssjön lake, there are other lakes and forest tarns in the Lake Revsund area that are known by fishing enthusiasts far and wide, both in Sweden and abroad.

Perhaps the most famous of these is **Gimån river** which meanders some 80 kilometres over rapids and waterfalls. It's meant to be one of the best places for trout fishing in Europe, and it also contains grayling. You can buy a fishing pass and find more information about the waters in the area at https://gimriver.se/. We promise that if you love fishing, you'll be kept busy for a long time in Lake Revsund.

Apart from being a place for fantastic fishing, Gimån river is also known for being the hub of timber floating in Jämtland from the 1840s until the 1970s. Remains from those times can still be found. After the timber floating ended the river was restored to create a more favourable environment for the fish.

Ice-fishing through holes in the lake ice is a popular activity in winter. Every Easter an ice-fishing competition is held next to Camp Viking campsite, and it attracts many fishing enthusiasts. But be careful on the ice, especially at the beginning and the end of the winter season.

The magnificent nature of the watercourses in Lake Revsund simply must be experienced. There are plenty of waterside accommodation options if you want to stay for a while.
