

# Campsites and RV parks in Lake Revsund

**Long – approx. 1700 characters**

Take the day as it comes in your home on wheels. Regardless of whether it's a lifestyle you already live or a future dream you have, it can feel good to plan in advance. The areas around Lake Revsund offer plenty of beautiful places to park your caravan, mobile home or camper van, or to pitch your tent. We mention some of them below. Which spot will become your home for the night?

**Camp Viking campsite** is conveniently located close to the E14 and right next to Revsundssjön lake. There's plenty of space to move around, either in the green areas on the campsite or along one of the many hiking trails in the area. But if you'd rather take it easy, we recommend the beach for bathing and some sun. Or why not try your luck at fishing? Electricity, water and toilet emptying facilities are also available.

It's simple to turn off the road to **Alma ångbåtsbrygga**, a steam boat pier in Stavre where you can park by the water. Just as the name suggests, this is the home of the illustrious Alma steam boat that operates on Revsundssjön lake during summer. There are some spaces with electricity as well as normal RV parking spaces. Go for a walk on the long Alma pier in the warm evening sun and enjoy the surroundings.

Do you want to stay close to where there are plenty of activities? In that case, park at one of the RV parks beside **Äventyrsberget in Gällö**. If you want some variety, you can try staying in one of their gorgeous glamping tents, or why not sleep under the stars in one of their tree tents? They also have cabins if you prefer to sleep indoors. Ski in the tunnel, go kayaking, test the high-rope course or visit the outlook area where there's a teepee and a tent for a daytime barbecue on the mountain. Then choose your favourite bed to sleep in for the night.
